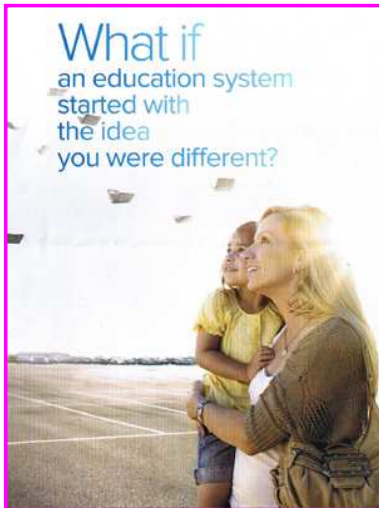

Many parents have inquired about the process of casting and jobs. Here is a brief outline of what happens: -

- Clients will either ring or email us with a 'brief'. The brief outlines the specifics of what they are looking for e.g. age, size, appearance, skills etc.
- We submit all the actors/models who fit the brief to the client.
- The client then selects the children they would like to see for a casting. We return ring all parents with the details of this casting and the likely shoot dates.
- Should your child be successful, we do not find out the details for the job until the day before. We will





call you as soon as the call sheet comes in.

Please be aware that details usually come in at the close of the business day, so until that time we do not have any information about the shoot.

- We unfortunately do not have the time to ring every parent if your child was not successful from the casting. However, we welcome inquires via email: bubblegumkids7@gmail.com. Please email us instead of calling, as we may not know the outcome of the job yet. When we do, we will respond.
