WORK TIMES - Please remember to call in the times your children work as we are NOT told by our clients how long our kids were on set. It is essential that we know your hours so we can invoice correctly.





TARGET have moved buildings. Target shoots will from now on take place at 486 Swan Street, Richmond, next door to where they were. Parking is in the Street, not in the carpark as there are now other photographers and businesses sharing the available off street parking.

On arrival at 486 Swan Street, please go to the door closest to the brick wall on the right hand side when you are facing the building. Go up a few stairs to Reception, advise the Receptionist that you are there and take a seat along the wall. Wait there until a Stylist comes to get you. As there are other Photographers using the facilities it is requested that you do not wander around the building. We have also been asked to tell you not to take extra people with you to the shoots if possible. We understand that sometimes it is not possible to have siblings looked after. Also there is a small space under the stairs to store strollers whilst the little one is doing the shoot.



PERMITS - As we are now into a new year, children who have just started school, changed schools or changed grade will need to issue Target and Kmart (Huge and PMP) with new permits signed by the Principle of the School. Our permits for all the school aged children will be out of date also. It would be great if the Schools would sign a few spare copies that you can post to us here at Bubblegum, signed by the parent or guardian also BUT NOT DATED. Makes life easier as so many of the jobs are quite rushed. However some schools will not do this without the job details completed.

PERMITS for Huge Studios and PMP Digital can be found in the Document section after you login to our website. There is a blank permit there also that can be printed out.

WEBSITE - As you all know it is very important that our Website is up to date so if you haven't sent us updated information and photos within the last three to four months then can you do it now. The more recent the information the better the chances of getting work.



Our annual Photo shoot is not too far away and we will send out this information and paperwork in due course.
